I then went on to serve as Outreach Coordinator last year, where I boosted our clubs revenue and musical prestige on campus, and in the overall community. Now, as President, I am committed to taking our group to new heights.

I am proud to announce that we have officially begun the transition towards new concert uniforms! The Executive Board has been working hard to ensure that these new uniforms meet our standards for quality, comfort, and versatility that our clubbers deserve. The pieces that we feel meet these requirements have been selected and brought forward for testing by clubbers to ensure that it meets their wants and needs. 

This semester, we welcomed 35 new singers into WGC, expanding our club significantly to pre-pandemic numbers. Let's meet some of our new glees!






